1. Story Problem

Twenty-two people board the bus at stop #1, seven people board at the bus stop #2, twelve board at stop #3, at stop #4 eight people unboard. How many people are on the bus when it arrives at stop #5?

Seventeen people are on the bus, after stop # 2 there are forty-three people on the bus. If seven people boarded at the bus stop #1, how many got on at stop #2?

Twenty-three people are on the bus, seven people unboard at the bus stop #13, twenty board at stop #14, at stop #15 eighteen people unboard. How many people are on the bus when it arrives at stop #16?

4. Story Problem

Three families of five are on the bus, seven people board at the bus stop #15, two families of seven board at stop #16, at stop #17 eight people unboard. How many people are on the bus when it arrives at stop #18?

5. Story Problem

Thirty-nine people are on the bus, thirteen people board at the bus stop #8, twelve people unboard at stop #9, at stop #10 four board and six unboard. How many people are on the bus when it arrives at stop #11?

Fifty-five people are on the bus, fifteen people board at the bus stop #1, one person gets off at stop # 4, twelve board at stop #5, at stop #6 eight people unboard. How many people are on the bus when it arrives at stop #4?
